#### **Asphalt Driveway Aftercare**

#### **Understanding Asphalt Sealing**

Asphalt sealing protects your driveway from sunlight, rain, and daily wear. The sealer bonds to the surface to prevent oxidation, cracking, and water penetration.

#### Immediate Aftercare

- Avoid all traffic for 48–72 hours after sealing.
- Prevent debris, water, or oil from contacting the surface.
- Keep pets and children away until fully cured.

#### Ongoing Maintenance

- Sweep regularly to remove dirt and grit.
- Clean small stains with mild soap and water.
- Reseal every 2–3 years for consistent protection.

Pro Tip: On very hot days, avoid parking in the same place repeatedly to prevent softening.



#### **Interlock Driveway Aftercare**

#### **Understanding Interlock Sealing**

Sealing interlock enhances the colour of the stones and protects the joints from erosion, weed growth, and shifting. Proper maintenance will preserve its vibrancy and structure.

#### **Maintenance Tips**

- Stay off the surface for 24 hours after sealing.
- Sweep joints regularly and refill polymeric sand when necessary.
- Avoid high-pressure washing that can dislodge joint sand.
- Reseal every 2-4 years to maintain the finish.

Pro Tip: Sweep joint sand after every heavy rainfall to prevent erosion and weed regrowth.

#### **Concrete Driveway Aftercare**

#### Why Sealing Matters

Concrete is porous and prone to absorbing water and stains. A proper sealer prevents penetration from oils, salts, and freeze—thaw damage.

#### Care Instructions

- Avoid walking or driving on the surface for 48 hours after sealing.
- Use mild soap and water for cleaning never bleach or acids.
- Avoid de-icing salts during winter; use sand instead.
- Reseal every 3-4 years.

Pro Tip: Seal your concrete before winter to prevent damage caused by Ontario's freeze-thaw cycle.
